# The first & original A brief history 1913

In 1913, Daniel J. O'Conor and Herbert A. Faber file a patent application for a process using paper and resin to make laminated insulators. John G. Tomlin joined the two to form the "Formica Products Company". The partners plan to produce commutator V-rings in which laminate is used as a replacement for the mineral mica, which is where the name **for-mica** was born.

The radio revolution - Formica® Laminate is used for insulating boards and the polished outer box on radio sets

In 1922, Formica® is registered for the first time as a trademark.

In 1927, the company creates its first decorative laminate, this signifies the beginning of a shift in focus from industrial to decorative products.

## 1930's

First published use of Formica® Laminates on kitchen surfaces.

In 1936 Formica® Laminate is installed in all bathrooms of Cunard's ocean liner, *RMS Queen Mary* when it begins service. Decades later, Formica® Laminates are used extensively for the interiors of the Queen Elizabeth 2 (QE2).

## 1940's

The Formica® brand enters international markets through a licensing agreement with the respected British firm, De La Rue.




In 1948 the North Shields factory opens in Tyne & Wear.

## 1950's

Industrial designer Brooks Stevens designs the company's first graphic invention - the still iconic 'Skylark' pattern, which was later renamed 'Boomerang' in 1954.


In 1940, only one quarter of the company's earnings come from the sale of decorative laminate, with the remainder coming from industrial products, by 1950, that ratio is reversed.

In 1953, De La Rue reports that the use of Formica® Laminate has expanded considerably internationally as a recognised material for equipping a modern kitchen.

1960's

In 1964, at the World's Fair in New York, Formica Group unveil a show house celebrating the versatility of Formica® Laminate in modern home design, on walls, furniture, and cabinetry. It proves a popular attraction, offering visitors a glimpse into the future of home living.

1970's

The U.S. Federal Trade Commission (FTC) seeks to cancel the Formica® brand trademark, charging that the word "Formica" has become a generic term for decorative laminate products. This creates an uproar in the business community which views this as an attempt to eradicate the function of trademarks in the economy. Ultimately the FTC's action was dropped.

## 1980's

40 years later and utilising this ColorCore technology, Formica Aria® 12 and 20mm through colour compact worktops are available today.

In the event that a product fails to conform to this limited warranty, Formica shall, at its sole option and discretion, either repair or replace such product.

This limited warranty does not cover any damages attributed to causes unrelated to Formica's manufacturing process, including but not limited to incorrect, faulty or improper handling and/or installation, damages caused by unreasonable use, misuse, physical abuse, accidental damage, normal wear and tear, exposure to corrosive elements in the atmosphere, mildew, or the use of harmful cleaning compounds.

   Due to the inherent properties of platinum etchings, metallic and gloss splashbacks and upstands, extreme care should be taken on installation to avoid scratching.
   Formica Group cannot accept any responsibility for the surface performance of these products if the owner/user fails to follow the installation and care guidelines.
- Please consult the installation guide prior to installation.

The Formica® Laminate Worktop Installation and Maintenance guide has been developed for guidance only. Formica Group cannot accept responsibility for the final fitting of your worktop. Colour and surface finish should be checked before installation. Formica Group will not accept any claims for re-fitting costs resulting from mis-matched surface colour or finish. To ensure that your laminate worktop remains in excellent condition, it is essential that all exposed edges of the chipboard are sealed with a silicone sealant or contact adhesive. For a sink cut-out, the exposed raw chipboard should be treated with a water seal or varnish. In addition to this, we would also recommend the use of a purpose made gasket, often supplied with the sink or silicone sealant applied to the perimeter of the sink prior to installation. The hob cut-outs can be protected in the same way but it is also advisable to cover the exposed edges and the edge of the laminate with aluminium foil, to prevent the heat affecting the cut-out.
